

## **Guide to Academic Advising for TCU Majors in Economics**

### **1. Freshmen**

Freshmen in the AddRan College of Liberal Arts and pre-majors (undecided students) are advised by full-time professional advisors in the Center for Academic Services (Sadler Hall, Room 1022, tel. 817-257-7486).

### **2. Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors**

Sophomores, juniors, and seniors who have declared a major in Economics will be assigned an academic advisor who will assist in assessing career possibilities, planning academic programs, scheduling classes, and handling any other academic questions that may develop. The academic advisor is a faculty member of the Department of Economics. To find out who your academic advisor is, sign into <http://my.tcu.edu> and go to your "student center." Your advisor's name will be posted in your "student center." If you change your major, you will receive a new advisor in your new major department.
